<ul> <li>Globally, does the website earn at least 2 stars?</li> <li>Is the information relevant to the topic of my research?</li> <li>Is the information reliable and confirmed by the two other sources?</li> <li>If my question is "yes" to these three questions, I can use the website as a source for my research</li> </ul>	search.
